• UNFCCC 1992 stabilization.. prevent dangerous interference in climate

• Kyoto 1997 developed countries must limit or reduce emissions

Paris 2015 limit temperature rise; foster resilience; redirect finance (all)

• Glasgow 2021 urgency this decade; phase down coal; phase out subsidies
